

“DISNEY’S AUXILIRATION”

For Auxiliary Units, Pom Squads,
and Color Guards

SUMMARY

“Disney’s Auxiliration” gives your auxiliary/color guard the unique opportunity to rehearse and to perform a simulated Disney “special event” production. Following a high-energy warm-up, your students will learn valuable flag and movement basics. Next, in a fun upbeat atmosphere, students go through a mock Disney Audition. Congratulations, you passed the Audition! Now it is time to prepare for the special event complete with tall flag, swing flag and show props. Then, your students go through a fun-filled, Disney-style rehearsal. The workshop culminates in an exhilarating simulated performance incorporating all of the equipment and props the students have learned in a ‘final’ Disney Production number.

KEY LEARNING POINTS

Equipment and Movement Basics:

- Demonstrate the use of auxiliary equipment emphasizing safety practices related to auxiliary activities including warm-ups, equipment warm-up and flag basics.
- Demonstrate correct body alignment, strength, flexibility, and coordination in the performance of technical movements.

Audition Skills:

- Participate in a mock audition.
- Gain insight for what judges are looking for in a final performance or in competition.
- Learn important audition tips.

Professionalism:

- Discover what it takes to be a part of a dedicated and focused unit.
- Learn how versatility on several pieces of equipment can open the door to opportunity.
- Understand how having the right attitude can make or break a career.

Combinations:

- Learn nationally recognized movement and equipment basics.
- Learn routines that incorporate tall flags, swing flags, props, and movement.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- “Disney’s Auxiliration” is taught by Disney Cast Members that are active in the color guard movement. Your instructor will take your students through a complete instructional lesson, a “real world” style audition, complete rehearsal, and a simulated production performance.
- Your Workshop will take place in a special Disney rehearsal facility.
- Choreography will be adjusted to ensure performance success based on the group’s ability level.
- To maximize rehearsal time, your students will be taught specific techniques and focus on a great final performance.
- All auxiliary and color guard equipment will be provided.
- Students should wear clothes and shoes that are appropriate for a color guard rehearsal. Dance and athletic shoes are considered appropriate for this workshop. Please no sandals or bare feet.
