SUMMARY

“Disney’s Show Choir Magic” will provide your students with a very special opportunity of rehearsing for a Disney Production. Led by a professional Disney clinician, your students will experience what a professional performer undergoes during the final stages of preparing a new show. Throughout the workshop the students will focus on the fundamentals of being a “Triple Threat.” The workshop culminates in a special mock performance incorporating all of the necessary elements to create a “Disney Magical Moment.”

KEY LEARNING POINTS

Vocal:

- Practice breathing techniques designed to produce better vocal quality.
- Learn simple techniques to improve diction.
- Learn tips for creating united vowel sounds.
- Learn Disney techniques for adding “style” to your performances.

Movement:

- Learn the concepts of staging and understand how blocking can enhance your performance.
- Rehearse and polish fundamental dance steps.
- Practice tips for projecting energy.
- Discover the proper way to coordinate vocals with movement.

Putting It All Together:

- Learn and perform a musical segment from an actual Disney show with choreography created just for “Disney’s Show Choir Magic.”

WHAT TO EXPECT

- “Disney’s Show Choir Magic” will be taught by a professional Disney clinician who will take your group through a fast paced, invigorating “real world” rehearsal and backstage performance experience.
- Your workshop will take place in a special Disney rehearsal facility.
- Choreography may be adjusted to ensure final performance success based on the group’s ability level.
- Your students will be taught specific techniques to maximize rehearsal time and focus on a great performance.
- To better prepare for the workshop the music will be premailed. We ask that groups rehearse the music and choose soloist(s) before arriving for the workshop.
