### SUMMARY

“Disney Sings - Young Performer Edition” introduces your group to elements of professional vocal performance. Your students will record an excerpt from a Disney animated feature film's soundtrack led by a professional Disney vocalist. Your students will also experience the demands and exhilaration of live performance as they prepare the actual music and choreography from a Disney entertainment production number.

### KEY LEARNING POINTS

#### Vocal Warm Ups:

- Discover how good posture positively affects breath control.
- Learn vocal production techniques and vowel exercises that improve diction and unified sounds.

#### Vocal Styles:

- Examine varied musical styles to learn the different vocal production techniques that are required in the music industry.
- Learn how professional singers must be flexible in their approach to songs and voice-overs.

#### Recording Professionalism:

- Experience the excitement and expectations of a studio vocalist.
- Learn the requirements of the recording environment.

#### Putting It All Together:

- Learn a musical selection and basic choreography from a Disney production number.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- “Disney Sings - Young Performer Edition” will be conducted by a professional Disney vocalist who will take your group through a fast-paced reading, recording, and performance experience.
- Your workshop will take place in a special Disney rehearsal facility.
- All music will be provided at your workshop, and taught by the Disney clinician and accompanist.
- Selected Music is scored to ensure success based on the group's ability level.
- Choreography is limited to movement on choral risers.
