To inspire students to actively participate in the protection and preservation of wildlife by taking part in an interactive survival game throughout *Disney’s Animal Kingdom*®.

Animal Behavior

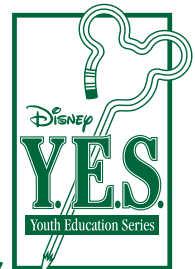
- Students observe, and mimic a wide variety of animal survival behaviors.
- A ride on *Kilimanjaro Safaris* gives students an exciting introduction to African wildlife and a chance to observe, categorize, collect, and analyze data on a wide variety of animal behaviors.
- Students journey through *Pangani Forest Exploration Trail* while discovering how animals’ natural adaptations aid them in survival.
- In *Asia*, students explore how human behavior can aid or strain an ecosystems’ resources.

Social Structures and Survival

- The greatest challenges to a species survival are experienced, focusing on natural adaptation and the human component.
- During observations of animals on the *Pangani Forest Exploration Trail* and *Maharajah Jungle Trek*, students compare social structures of animals from all around the world.
